Fulton County Receives Wellness Grant for 2016

Fulton County is pleased to be the recipient of a \$10,096.00 Wellness grant from the County Employee Benefits Consortium of Ohio for 2016. Laura Howell, Director of Organizational Development and Wellness Committee Chair notes, "This will be the third consecutive year we've received this grant from CEBCO, and each year, we continue to add programming that supports the Fulton County Wellness Program's Mission." The mission of the Wellness program is to provide all members with the tools and support to become healthy, productive individuals in work and life. The theme for 2016 is "Well-Being in 2016," and will feature a series of Lunch and Learn Educational sessions, "Organized Walks," Waist Watchers program and messaging throughout county buildings. Also back by popular demand will be the "Fuel Your Day" initiative in which fresh vegetables and fresh fruit will be delivered to each county department throughout the year. "The Fulton County Commissioners have historically recognized the importance of improving the connection between employee and family health and controlling the health and benefits costs of county government. This grant allows us to continue to move that vision forward!" states Howell.
