## Did You Know?

In 1850, county commissioners chose "Ottokee" as the site for the first county courthouse. In 1851, a two-story frame building was constructed. This building housed a court and jury rooms on the top floor with county offices on the ground floor. The courthouse was later destroyed by a fire.

The new shared services complex building adjacent to the Robert Fulton Building will feature an exterior replica of that very first courthouse (see photo to the left)!
