## Fulton County to Offer Veteran ID Cards

In a collaborative effort, Fulton County Recorder Sandy Barber and Fulton County Veterans Service Office Director Crystal Bennett are pleased to announce that they will now be able to issue Veteran ID Cards to Fulton County Veterans. With recent legislation passed in 2016, and with the Fulton County Board of Commissioners approval, Veteran ID Cards will be available at no charge through the Recorder's office beginning on March 1st, 2017. "This is something we are thrilled to do for our veterans for all they have done for us during their service," says Barber.

"These ID cards will make it easier for veterans to use at restaurants, hotels, and other places of business versus having to show their DD214 (discharge) papers," noted Bennett.

To kickoff this service, Barber and Bennett are taking appointments on March 1st, 2nd and 3rd from 9:00 am– 4:30pm at the Fulton County Administration Building. Veterans will need to bring two forms of identification, one being a photo ID. These items are listed at this web address [www.fultoncountyoh.com/recorder](http://www.fultoncountyoh.com/recorder) or can be obtained by contacting the Recorder's office at 419-337-9232. After March 3rd, no appointment will be necessary and veterans can visit the Recorder's office between the hours of 8:30am-4:30pm.
