9:14:53 AM		1st Hearing- Ditch 2151 Gorham Township – Rod Creager said that this was a single county ditch petition filed by Gorham Township. There are no records of any past improvements, except the Myers Farm was drained to the north to Deer Creek. The objective is to control the surface water that comes out of the sediment basin outlets, provide an outlet for subsurface drainage from buffers and roadside and establish an outlet with a permanent maintenance program. Some of the observed problems are standing water at the northern basin, saturated buffer area at middle basin, and orifice plates have been removed. The proposed work would be to install a 15 inch tile to drain to Deer Creek, install catch basins and restore buffer areas and roadsides. The estimated project cost would be \$188,896.71 which includes construction, Engineers cost, Clerks cost and first year maintenance.

		that gets damaged that it be repaired. In the agreement they are supposed to fix any damaged tile which he thinks they have attempted to fix some. Mr. Myers has reached out to a company that has a camera that can go the length of the tile. He has asked Arche if they will cover the cost to fix any tile found damaged or if he has to cover that cost if anything is located with the camera. Mr. Myers mentioned that there was a 15 inch main that should be taking most of the water away but they have built a retention pond on top of it.

They have altered the natural flow of the water. They have man-made change to all of this. I think it is due to all their fields they put in and we have no way to know how much damage they have done to Darrin's field. They have created the problem but have no fix for it.
