The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Kenneth at 7:00 pm.

Linda Lauber presented the May zoning report (attachment 01-06-15).

The Board of Zoning Appeals approved a variance to permit Codey Woodby to erect an accessory building measuring 60' x 40' which is larger than the home, in his front yard as there is not enough space in the back yard on his property located at 25950 Co Rd F, Archbold, OH 43502. Bruce made a motion to approve the Board of Zoning Appeals decision. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Randy made a motion to permit Codey Woodby to construct a driveway at 25950 Co Rd F, Archbold, OH 43502. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The minutes from the May 26, 2015 meeting were presented. Randy made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Super Blanket Certificate 34-2015 was presented for signatures.

The bank reconciliation for May 2015 was presented for review.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 02-06-15). Randy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh reported they have been mowing ditches, last weekend all the high water signs were placed, helped Randy Oyer get power for the salt building, repairing a tile on Co Rd F.

The May 2015 financial reports were presented for review.

Randy made a motion to request an estimate from the Fulton County Engineer's Office for the Asphalt resurfacing of Co Rd 24 from Brush Creek North to the Railroad tracks with a grind out of the pavement by Lyle Friesen's residence. This estimate will be used to apply for Issue II funding. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Randy reported the county dipped out a ditch on Co Rd 24 and placed the corn stalks on the property and it is then the landowner's responsibility to remove them.
