The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Kenneth at 7:00 pm.

The minutes from the June 22, 2015 meeting were presented. Randy made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The bank reconciliation for June 2015 was presented for review.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 01-07-15). Bruce made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh reported they have been dealing with flooding, pulled back some berm, flushed some tile, cleaned the building for the township party, dug ditch on G, worked on fire truck 105 serviced pick up.

The June 2015 financial reports were presented for review.

Linda Lauber presented the June zoning report (attachment 02-07-15).

Bill Roth wants to demonstrate a ditch maker machine. Bruce will try to get a date set up.

Kenneth submitted information to OTARMA for the \$500.00 safety grant (attachment 03-07-15)..

Bruce and Kenneth met with the Fulton County Engineer regarding the Pettisville storm water district and Jones & Henry firm was selected to process plans.

**09-15 RESOLUTION TO REQUEST AN ESTIMATE ROAD STRIPING**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio approved to request an estimate from the Fulton County Engineer for center striping Road 26-2 from State Route 2 to Williams County Line (1/2 mile), Road FG from Road 26 to Road 27 (1 mile), Road 20-2 from Road A to Road C (2 mile), Road G from Road 20-A to Road 27 (3 1/2 mile), Road E from Road 25 to Williams County Line (2 mile) and Road 24 from Road A to State Route 20A.

Discussion was made regarding the lease with Xtreme Automotive Detailing for the building at 5001 State Route 66 which expires at the end of July. Bruce made a motion to renew the lease at \$250.00 per month for another year. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Andy said the fire department has talked about refurbishing truck 104 and 108. He has received an estimate for Engine 104 for \$153,000.00. An estimate or Engine 108 was received for \$165,000.00. The Officers are requesting to have Engine 104 done first. Someone from Sutphen would come and go over the estimate with the department. There is currently a lead time of six weeks to get the truck in and four months to refurbish the truck. The trustees recommended the department have Sutphen give a final estimate for 104.

Andy said they will be ordering some 2 ½ inch hose for each of the trucks which will cost approximately \$3,500.00.

Andy discussed the idea of putting up a building on the township property to be used as a training facility and wondered what the trustees response was. A question was raised about who is responsible for any injuries during training. Andy will check on the liability questions. The trustees told Andy they were in favor of having the department erect a training facility on the township property pending the response about the liability question.

Andy said they are purchasing some new radios and some new head sets.

Bruce made a motion to adjourn at 8:45 pm. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
