The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

Present: Bruce Lauber, Kenneth Leupp, Randy Ruffer (left at 8:30), Keith Short

Guests: Josh King, Robert Apper, Linda Lauber, Andy Brodbeck

The meeting was called to order by Kenneth at 7:00 pm.

The minutes from the July 27, 2015 meeting were presented. Randy made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with two yes votes and no negative votes.

The bank reconciliation for July 2015 was presented for review.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 01-08-15). Bruce made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh reported they have been mowing ditches, did some patching in alley in Elmira, sprayed weeds around guardrails, a tile is broken down on Co Rd 27 and there are spots on Co Rd 25 which need to be repaired.

The July 2015 financial reports were presented for review.

Robert Apper discussed the drawings of Johnson Cemetery and said that on the older drawings there was not a date listed. The newer drawings have the dates on the drawings.

Linda Lauber presented the July zoning report (attachment 02-08-15).

Bruce suggested we should decide what we would charge for stone from our lot if someone inquires about buying some.

Andy reported that Sutphen came through with a quote of \$197,397.86 for refurbishing truck #104 and the department is going to go through the quote to see why it is a higher quote than the previous \$154,000.00 (attachment 03-08-15).

Andy said the EMS contracts have been written and the next step is for the County Commissioners to review them and then all parties will sign the contracts.

Andy with Bob Seaman, Archbold Engineer recommended they talk with Dave Nafziger about adding a training structure to our building and Dave recommended not adding it to the existing building. The fire Department is looking at other site options to consider.

Daniel Heer sent a letter regarding the need for a new outlet tile under Co Rd F and a catch basin for drainage (attachment 04-08-15). Kenneth will contact Mr. Heer and Randy Nofziger, the landowner, to invite them to attend a meeting to discuss this situation.
