November 9, 2015

The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

Present: Bruce Lauber, Kenneth Leupp, Randy Ruffer, Keith Short

Guests: Josh King, Linda Lauber, Stephen Lange, Andy Brodbeck

The meeting was called to order by Kenneth at 7:00 pm.

The minutes from the October 26, 2015 meeting was presented. Bruce made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The bank reconciliation for October 2015 was presented for review.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 01-11-15). Randy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh reported they have been mowing ditches, worked on trucks, prepared the snow plows, took a tree down on Co Rd 25, saw a demonstration from Archbold Equipment for a power ditching machine and will be taking the pick up to Kalida Truck to have them check the snow plow.

The October 2015 financial reports were presented for review.

Linda Lauber presented the October zoning report (attachment 02-11-15).

Andy presented a final quotation received from Sutphen Corporation to refurbish truck #104 in the amount of \$196,851.44 instead of the previous last quote of \$198,218.00 (attachment 03-11-15). Andy said he is going to check with zoning about how many containers the fire department can place on our property. If allowed they will be placing a total of five containers. The EMS levy has passed by over 2,000 votes and the department should start to see these funds in 2017. The EMS contract is be rewritten by the Commissioners and Andy believes it will be signed this week and this contract will take effect in February, 2016.

Bruce made a motion to purchase a rotary ditching machine from Archbold Equipment for \$5,950.00 (attachment 04-11-15). Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Randy said the Village of Archbold is doing some surveying on Co Rd 22 to put in a new water line. They are also in discussion with the county to possibly widen Co Rd 22.

There was some discussion regarding a health care plan and are waiting for some questions to be clarified before making any decision.
