The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Randy at 7:00 pm.

Steven Lange presented the March zoning report (attachment 01-04-16).

Jeff Wyse appeared to discuss a situation with water on FG that runs East on the North side of the road. He would like to have a tile put in to help the water drain. It would require about 620 feet of 18" tile for approximately \$4,500.00. Mike Short Construction and quoted a price of \$3,500.00 to install the tile. The Trustees would like to look at the situation before making a decision.

The minutes from the March 28, 2016 meeting were presented. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The March 2016 bank statement was presented for review.

Josh reported they worked on the ditch mower and the lawn mower. The Sheriff Department dropped off some motorcycle signs. The March 2016 financial reports were presented for review.

Kenneth attended a meeting regarding the storm sewer in Pettisville.

Randy reported that Ryan Terry will be here on Tuesday at 10:30 to look at some of our roads that need to be worked on to make recommendations.
