### GET YOU MOTOR RUNNING WITH AUBURN DAY TRIP

You are invited to ride along on a day trip to the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Automobile Museum on Tuesday, August 23, in Auburn, Indiana. The Auburn Cord Duesenberg facility was a factory where cars were hand-assembled, rather than mass-produced. The museum is organized into seven galleries that display about 125 cars and related exhibits such as restored Auburn Automobile company offices. Some exhibits have interactive kiosks that allow visitors to hear the sounds the car makes and to see related videos and photographs that show details of what is under the hood of the car.
