The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

09-16 RESOLUTION TO REQUEST AN ESTIMATE ROAD STRIPING

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio approved to request an estimate from the Fulton County Engineer for water based for center striping of Road 25 from Road B to dead end (4.56 miles), Road 21-3 from Road A to Road B (1 mile) and Road 26 from Road E to Road G (2 miles) and a preference of polyester center striping on Road F between Road 19 and Road 21 (2 miles), and Road B from Road 19 to Road 20 (1 mile), and Road B from Road 21 to Archbold Village Limits (1 ½ mile).
