August 22, 2016

The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

Present: Bruce Lauber, Kenneth Leupp, Randy Ruffer, Keith Short

The meeting was called to order by Randy at 7:00 pm.

The minutes from the August 8, 2016 meeting were presented. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 04-08-16). Bruce made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh asked Brady Township about striping Co Rd 27 and billing us but they said it would be better if we added it to our striping work and they finished up the tile project on Co Rd FG. He asked Mike Short to give us a quote for the tile work on Co Rd B between Co 24 and Co Rd 25. Josh received an estimate to repair Truck #103. They have sold quite a bit of stone.

An estimate was received from Rittel, Hill & Zimmerman Insurance Services, Inc. in the amount of \$12,898.30 to repair the 1983 Ford L9000 fire truck #103 (attachment 05-08-16). The information for the estimate was furnished by Selking International Idealease in Bryan. The Township is to authorize the repairs and the shop is to call agent Michael G. Fenneman at 614-457-7765 if they are going to run over and above the estimate. Bruce made a motion to accept the estimate and to authorize the repair work. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Kenneth said Mike Burkholder from the engineer's office said the striping for the roads will be all water based.

Randy asked if everyone had a chance to review the information the Village Council sent regarding the fire department equipment. Randy said he told Donna Dettling that the trustees would not be attending the Council meeting.

Kenneth made a motion to adjourn at 8:15 pm. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
