The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Randy at 7:00 pm.

Steve Lange, Zoning Inspector for the Township, gave his report for the month of October (attachment 01-11-16).

The minutes from the October 24, 2016 meeting were presented. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Bruce presented the October bank statement for review. Bruce, Randy, and Kenneth signed and dated the statement.

Bruce presented the bills for review (attachment 02-11-16). Bruce made a motion to except the bills as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The October 2016 financial reports were presented for review.

Josh reported the county no longer wants to plow Co. Rd. H west of St. Rt. 66. We need to send a letter to Franklin Twp. to verify we will plow this section of road every other year starting the winter of 2016 and 2017.

The county also wants to trade plowing duty for Road 20, from State Route 2 to Road A and Road D from Road 22 to the Williams County line (attachment 03-11-16). We'll plow 20 again and they'll plow D.

Josh reported Tracy Gleason asked to put a tile in the ditch in front of where he wants to build a new house on Co. Rd. F. We agreed to allow it.

They graded the berm on Co. Rd. 24 and B and fixed a tile on Co. Rd. 24 and E, worked on the International dump truck, serviced PTO, transmission, and the leaking air tanks.

We issued a driveway permit for Barry Hoylman and Scott King.

Kenneth made a motion to petition the Dinius tile on Co. Rd. F and the Baer tile on Co. Rd. G. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Bruce made a motion to adjourn. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
