FULTON COUNTY TO OFFER VETERAN ID CARDS

In a collaborative effort, Fulton County Recorder Sandy Barber and Fulton County Veterans Service Office Director Crystal Bennett are pleased to announce that they will now be able to issue Veteran ID Cards to Fulton County Veterans. With recent legislation passed in 2016, and with the Fulton County Board of Commissioners' approval, Veteran ID Cards will be available at no charge through the Recorders office beginning on March 1st, 2017. "This is something we are thrilled to do for our veterans for all they have done for us during their service," Barber said. "These ID cards will make it easier for veterans to use at restaurants, hotels, and other places of business versus having to show their DD214 (discharge) papers," noted Bennett.
