The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

Present: Bruce Lauber, Kenneth Leupp, Randy Ruffer, Keith Short

Guests: Josh King, Stephen Lange, Donna Dettling, David Pugh

The meeting was called to order by Bruce at 7:00 pm.

Stephen Lange presented the March zoning report (attachment 01-04-17).

The minutes from the March 27, 2017 meeting were presented. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh reported they have been servicing fire trucks, there was a little flooding last weekend, sold quite a bit of stone, received all of our salt, met with the County at B and 19 who is repaving 19 and would like to change the intersection. Josh said he spoke with Miller Brothers to grind down the bumps on G before doing the micro surfacing who said they would do it at \$250.00 per hour.

Randy made a motion to have Miller Brothers proceed with grinding the bumps on G. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The March 2017 bank statement was presented for review.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 02-04-17). Randy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The March 2017 financial reports were presented for review.

Kenneth said Maumee Valley Planning have sent out mailings to home owners in Pettisville for the storm water project in Pettisville.

Bruce asked what the next steps should be regarding the fire department discussion. Kenneth said we should keep the fire equipment. Randy and Bruce both agreed. Donna said they would end the service contract. Bruce said he has had nine names of responses in favor of transferring the equipment to Archbold and he has had over seventy contacts in favor of the Township keeping the equipment. Randy said he thinks they should try to address the fairness of the fire department. Donna said a 2 mil levy total will get it done and the Township could keep the equipment. Donna said there are many people frustrated over this issue but hopes the levy in May will be passed. Donna recommended there be a meeting with Brett Kolb to discuss the levy process.

Randy made a motion to approve the quote from Strawser Construction, Inc. to apply a Micro seal finish to Co Rd G from State Route 20A to Co Rd 26, 26,788 square yards at \$3.02 per square yard for a total of \$80,899.76 which supersedes the motion from February 27, 2017 which was made for \$2.95 per square yard and to approve the quote to apply the Onyx Mastic Surface treatment to Co Rd B from Co 24 to Co Rd 25, 10,578 square yards and to Co Rd E from Co Rd 24 to Co Rd 25, 10,215 square yards at \$1.50 per

square yard for a total of \$31,189.50 (attachment 03-04-17). Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Randy made a motion to adjourn at 9:55 pm. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
