The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Bruce at 7:00 pm.

The minutes from the October 9, 2017 meeting were presented. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 05-10-17). Randy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh said he spoke with Rover pipeline about some of the crossings and dug up two places and took care of them and the company will be coming back through next year and will take care of any issues, did more Dura Patching, ready to start last mowing, Fire Department had some tire problems on Brush Truck #105 so they are looking at some other options for tires, checked on solar powered stop signs with Tapco at \$1,200.00 state bid price.

Kenneth said the Fulton County Engineers' office are going to award the bid on November 21, 2017 for the tile that crosses Co Rd G.

There was some discussion regarding the 2.0 mill levy. Bruce said if the Village is not going to support the levy and not reduce their levy by .7 mill then he is not sure there is a need to keep the levy on the ballot. Kenneth agreed with Bruce. Randy would be in favor of a 1.0 mill levy rather than a 2.0 mill levy.

Kenneth made a motion to have a special meeting on October 30, 2017 at 7:00 to discuss the 2.0 mill levy for the purpose of purchasing and maintaining fire apparatus, equipment and any related fire expenses which is scheduled to be on the 11/07/2017 General Election for 5 years commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Kenneth made a motion to adjourn at 7:32 pm. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
