2017 MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT RECAP

The 2017 Medicare Open Enrollment period was very successful here in Fulton County. Val met with 304 seniors during open enrollment to review Medicare drug and advantage. With Val's help, many seniors found a Prescription Drug Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan that helped save them money and get more coverage for their needs. This is especially important for those whose medications may have changed throughout the year and their current drug plan was not covering the changes. Other reasons to check your drug plan/advantage plan annually include increases in premiums, deductibles, and co-pays. Appointments can really pay off, as a total of over \$107,000 was saved for Fulton County Seniors this year. Medicare Open Enrollment is each year from October 15 to December 7. Appointments are mandatory during this time and go fast, so please mark your calendars and remember to give us a call in September to schedule your comparison. Thank you to all who helped make this year's Open Enrollment such a success and as always please keep in mind that Val is available to assist you with questions on Medicare and related topics. WHAT IS IT?

Golden Drummers – This exercise class raises your heart rate while you tap out rhythms to music. Choose your own intensity level as you tap drumsticks on large, stationary, exercise balls. Stand or sit for this class. No experience needed; simply follow the instructor.

Tai Chi – This exercise class increases balance & flexibility & fights stress. Follow an on-screen instructor via DVD. Movements are slow and fluid. Two class times available.

Senior Center Choir – More voices are always welcome to join! Join other seniors who enjoy singing and find a light-hearted comradery here. The Choir occasionally performs at other Senior Center sites, nursing homes, etc.
