NEW SCAM WITH NEW MEDICARE CARDS

If you're a senior on Medicare, **new** cards are coming soon. **New** cards will be mailed out between April 2018 and April 2019, and these **new** cards will no longer have your Social Security number on them. Be aware so you don't fall for a scam concerning these new cards. Medicare will NOT call you about your new Medicare card. DO NOT give your social security number or other personal information over the phone. The new Medicare card is FREE and there is NO processing fee. Do not believe someone who says you must pay for your new card. DO NOT give out your bank account information.

COUPONS FOR LOCAL FARMERS' MARKETS

If you are age 60 or over and a resident of Fulton County, you may be eligible to receive coupons from the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program. Eligible seniors receive ten \$5 coupons and a list of more than 130 participating farmers' markets and roadside stands. Coupons can be redeemed for fresh vegetables and fruits plus herbs and honey. If you live alone, your annual income must be no more than \$22,459. For a household of two, your annual income must be no more than \$30,451. Please contact Laura Ankney at 419-337-9299 for income requirements for households with up to 6 persons. You will automatically receive an application in the mail for 2018 if you received coupons for local farmers' markets in 2017. If you are homebound, you may assign a proxy to shop for produce for you. If you are new to the program and would like to apply for farmers' market coupons for the 2018 season, pick up an application at any of our five senior center sites. **Each household must complete an application every year.** Submit your completed application to Laura Ankney at the Wauseon site or to Area Office on Aging, Toledo. All applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. The Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program is made possible by funding from the United States Department of Agriculture and state and local funding.
