COCONUT CREAM PIE CAKE RECIPE

Ingredients:

- 1 box white cake mix (plus items needed to make the cake)
- 1 15-ounce can Cream of Coconut (refer to photo; find in Chief's baking aisle; Note: NOT coconut milk!)
- 1 8-ounce container Cool Whip, thawed; one 8-ounce package sweetened, flaked coconut.



Instructions:

1. First, prepare and bake white cake mix according to package directions for a 9 x 13 pan.
2. Then, remove cake from oven, and while still hot, poke holes all over the top of the cake using a large fork.
3. Open can of Cream of Coconut (not coconut milk!), stir contents, then pour over warm cake.
4. Next, evenly coat the whole cake and spread it around so Cream of Coconut will soak in.
5. After cake cools completely, frost with whipped topping. Top with flaked coconut.
