## WINTER WEATHER ALERTS

Winter weather is unpredictable. Have you taken action and stocked up on a few shelf-stable meals in your kitchen in the unlikely event that our Senior Center would be closed due to bad weather? Also, we thank you in advance for providing a safe way to bring your meal to your door. Your meal delivery driver appreciates it when you make their safety a priority and arrange to keep your driveway and sidewalks clear of snow and ice. If Senior Center activities or meals are canceled due to bad weather, you can expect to receive a phone call from our automated phone system. One Call Now will provide you with instructions in the event of a Level 2 or Level 3 snow emergency. Level 2 means meals, activities and transportation are canceled. Level 3 means all sites are closed.

## YOUR RESERVATION IS VITAL

If you are making a reservation for lunch at a Senior Center site or for home delivery, please note we require at least one business day's notice to add your reservation. Please do not leave meal reservation additions on the Senior Center voice mail system over a weekend for Monday's meal or for days following holidays, as we cannot accommodate your request. We also ask for your consideration if you are not able to keep your Senior Center lunch reservation. Please notify us right away of your cancelation. Our kitchen staff strives to be accurate in the amount of food it prepares. Accurate lunch reservation numbers result in much less food waste.

## SENIOR CENTER HAM LOAF RECIPE

1 ½ LB GROUND HAM

1 LB GROUND BEEF

½ LB GROUND PORK

3 EGGS

2 CUPS CRUSHED SALTINE CRACKERS

½ CUP MILK

1. In a large bowl combine all ingredients. Mix well and form into a loaf. Place loaf into a lightly greased 9x13 baking dish.
2. Bake at 350 degrees F for 90 minutes or until a thermometer inserted into the thickest part reads 165 degrees F.
3. While the loaf is baking, make a glaze of 1 cup catsup, ¼ cup plus 1 TBS brown sugar and 1 TBS mustard.
4. Mix well and spread over the loaf for the last 15 minutes of baking.
5. Let the loaf rest for 10 minutes before cutting and serving.
