Louis Herzog was born in Detroit, moved to Camden, Michigan with his family when he was twelve, and now lives near Fayette, Ohio. In grade school, Louis took pride in essay-writing assignments. He remembers his teacher, Mrs. Clark, encouraging him by saying, “You’re going to be famous someday!” Following school, he enlisted in the Korean War, hoping to be sent to Korea, but was sent to Germany, where he served as a Military Ammunition Supply Specialist from 1951 to 1953. Louis went on to work for and retire from UPS. Louis’ faith in God is very important to him. “No matter what I did and do, I think of Him,” Louis said. He believes God’s hand has been protecting him for more than eight decades. “I’m still here because there’s something I’ve gotta do yet,” Louis said. Remembering his early days in Mrs. Clark’s class, Louis has written poetry throughout the years as he felt inspired. Several pieces were published. The class time is 1:00 to 2:30 pm in the Fulton County Senior Center Bingo Room. This class is limited to ten seniors. All materials will be provided to create four small paintings. The cost for this series of classes is \$30 per person. Seniors with nut allergies, please be advised, Alice uses a walnut oil solvent. "Anyone can paint. I will teach them!" Alice said. DEMENTIA PROGRAMS

The Fulton County Senior Center in partnership with the Northwest Ohio chapter of Alzheimer's Association will present four programs in the coming four months. All will be presented by the chapter's Education Coordinator Dr. Lynn Ritter. The topic for March 19 will be "Healthy Living for Your Brain & Body." On April 23, Dr. Ritter will cover "Understanding Alzheimer's and Dementia." "Effective Communication Strategies" for someone with memory loss will be the program topic on May 22. The series will conclude on June 25 with "Understanding and Responding to Dementia-Related Behavior." All free programs will begin at 11:00 am at Fulton County Senior Center, 240 Clinton Street Wauseon. Make your lunch reservation at least 24 hours in advance for the noon meal by calling 419-337-9299. Suggested lunch donation \$2.00 for Fulton County residents age 60 and over; \$3.50 all others. Similar programs will be offered by Dr. Ritter at the other county Senior Center sites, as well.

WHAT IS IT?

1. **Pickleball** – This active game is for two or four players, uses a paddle and a Wiffle-type ball and combines elements of table tennis, tennis and badminton.
2. **Golden Drummers** – This exercise class raises your heart rate while you tap out rhythms to music. Choose your own intensity level as you tap drumsticks on large, stationary, exercise balls. Stand or sit for this class. No experience needed; simply follow the instructor.
3. **Tai Chi** – This exercise class increases balance & flexibility & fights stress. Follow an on-screen instructor via DVD. Movements are slow and fluid. Two class times available.
4. **Senior Center Choir** – More voices are always welcome to join! Join other seniors who enjoy singing and find a light-hearted comradery here. The Choir occasionally performs at other Senior Center sites, nursing homes, etc.
5. **Line Dancing** -- A great way to combine fitness and fun for both the body and brain. Features various music styles, not just country! New dancers are welcome anytime.
6. **Pepper** – A card game closely related to Euchre.
7. **Gentle Movement** – A fitness instructor from Fulton County Health Center leads this exercise class. Choose your intensity level and improve your muscle tone, flexibility and endurance. Stand for this class or sit as needed. Use small, handheld weights.
