October 22, 2018

The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for conducting business of the township.

Kenneth called the meeting to order at 7:30 am.

Present: Andy Brodbeck, Kenneth Leupp, Joe Short, Keith Short

Guests: Josh King, Jeff Aeschliman, Robert Apger, Dave Davis, Joe Garcia

Keith presented the minutes from the October 8, 2018 meeting. Joe made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Andy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Keith presented the bills for review (attachment 05-10-18). Andy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Joe seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Dave Davis said Sutphen serviced the tower last week and recommended a few things to repair. All testing of equipment is complete. The fire department issues address signs for residents in the country. There are also blue signs available for residents who have ponds that the fire department can access in case of a fire.

Josh said Gerken Paving, Inc. has started working on the roads.

Josh said they did some Dura Patching, trimmed some trees in Goll Woods, used the ditch slinger on a ditch, solar stop signs have been installed at the Henty-Fulton County line, there was an environmental spill on 21-3 and A, and inspected a catch basin by Sanford Wyse.

Josh will request an estimate from Dan Heer for the tile and catch basin repair work at Randy Ruffer's on Co Rd E. The Fulton County Engineers office will then be contacted to determine who pays what percent of the project.

Josh said there are two or three places where the tile is broken down by the Sanford Wyse residence. Sanford said he is willing to pay his share for the repair. Josh will get a cost estimate for the repair and then we will be able to decide what percent each landowner is responsible.

There was some discussion regarding property owned by Mr. Bentley in Elmira, who requested to have the alley extended. Josh will ask Mr. Bentley to attend the November 12 meeting at 7:00 pm to explain what he is requesting.

There was some discussion if the Township is responsible to plow some alleys in the township. Kenneth will ask the Fulton County Engineers office for advice in this matter.

Morton Salt sent a quote to purchase 200 tons of salt delivered at a price of \$81.22 per ton (attachment 06-10-18). Andy made a motion to purchase 100 ton of salt. The price last year was \$49.19 per ton and the year before \$55.45 per ton. Joe seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Jo Garcia from G T Contracting asked if they could finish the crack sealing. Josh will contact Gerken and let him know.
