Board of Trustees
February 25, 2019

The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for conducting business of the township.

Present: Andy Brodbeck, Kenneth Leupp, Joe Short, Keith Short

Guests: Josh King, Jeff Aeschliman, Jeff Fryman, Robert Apper, David Pugh.

Joe called the meeting to order at 7:30 am.

Keith presented the minutes from the February 11, 2019 meeting. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Joe seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Keith presented the bills for review (attachment 06-02-19). Kenneth made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Andy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Robert Apper reviewed the guidelines for cemeteries that Kenneth gave to him. Robert said there are maintenance grants available. He will need to go over the guidelines more thorough. There are two trees at Goll Woods Cemetery that should come down.

Joe said the Fire Contract with Franklin Township is soon due. After reviewing the contract with the Village of Archbold, there is a question as to whether the contract amount needs to be adjusted to the same rate German Township residents pay.

Josh said they have cleared roads, had some issues with trees and have had issues with the chain saw. The Trustees recommended they purchase a new chain saw.

The Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources was received from the Fulton County Auditor's office (attachment 07-02-19).

Kenneth discussed the process of cleaning Brush Creek.

Joe and Kenneth attended a meeting regarding the Ohio gasoline tax currently charged. There is discussion about raising the tax.

Joe presented a Release Agreement with Rover Pipeline for the RUMA (Road Use and Maintenance Agreement) around December 22, 2016 and various entities that needs to be signed by the trustees and returned to the Fulton County Engineer's office (attachment 08-02-19).

An application process through Maumee Valley Planning has been initiated and requires the trustees' signatures on the application. This will start the process to demolish the blighted property of Marlene Foor at Co Rd A and Co Rd 21-3.

Andy made a motion to adjourn at 8:05 am. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
