The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for conducting business of the township.

Joe called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Keith presented the minutes from the March 25, 2019 meeting. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Andy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Keith presented the March 2019 bank statement for review.

Keith presented the bills for review (attachment 01-04-19). Kenneth made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Andy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Joe said we have received information showing what additional funds German Township will receive because of the increase in the gasoline tax, which will be used for road repair. German Township will receive an estimated additional \$56,729.00 in 2020 and \$57,218.00 in 2021.

Joe said we need to get started getting quotes for conforming the ditches for Co Rd B between Road 20 and Road 21. He will contact suggested companies referred by the Fulton County Engineer's Office, and will contact the Engineer's office for plans and proper wording to put in the paper so any other companies can bid on the project.

Andy made a motion to adjourn at 7:55 pm. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
