SENIOR SPOTLIGHT

June's Spotlight shines on two World War II veterans. Both live near Swanton and regularly attend the Swanton Senior Center.

Bob Dietsch started attending the Swanton Senior Center in 2016. "The meals are all quite good. It's great for me to get out and see people," Bob explained. This nearly 95-year-old has beat cancer twice and exercises three days a week. He mows his three-acre yard and enjoys watching the wildlife that visit his woods. "I am a World War II veteran. I served in Africa, Sicily & Italy. I was a combat engineer." Bob spent his career as a tool and die maker. Bob had the privilege of attending an Honor Flight sponsored by the Swanton Sons of the American Legion 479. "That was great!" Bob said. The cap Bob is wearing in this photo is from the Honor Flight.

Keith and Ruth Ritenour met on a blind date. They agree it was love at first sight. In September, they will celebrate 70 years of marriage. For many years, they loved dancing, everything from Polka, Waltz and Ballroom to Rumba, Cha-Cha and Swing. Together, they take care of their home and Keith, age 93, cares for their three-acre yard. They savor homegrown tomatoes each summer. "We enjoy coming to the Swanton site for lunch regularly. It's always nice," Ruth said.

Keith is a WWII veteran. "I served in France, Germany and Austria. I was a combat infantry man," he said. Keith was awarded the Bronze Star medal and Silver Star medal for Gallantry in action in WWII. He saved his company of troops when he was in Germany.

COUpons FOR LOCAL FARMERS' MARKETS

If you are age 60 or over and a resident of Fulton County, you may be eligible to receive coupons from the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program. Eligible seniors receive ten \$5 coupons and a list of more than 130 participating farmers' markets and roadside stands. Coupons can be redeemed for fresh vegetables and fruits plus herbs and honey. If you live alone, your annual income must be no more than \$23,106. For a household of two, your annual income must be no more than \$31,283. Please contact Laura Ankney at 419-337-9299 for income requirements for households with up to 6 persons. You will automatically receive an application in the mail for 2019 if you received coupons for local farmers' markets in 2018. If you are homebound, you may assign a proxy to shop for produce for you. If you are new to the program and would like to apply for farmers' market coupons for the 2019 season, pick up an application at any of our five senior center sites. **Each household must complete an application every year.** Submit your completed application to Laura Ankney at the Wauseon site or to Area Office on Aging, Toledo. All applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. The Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program is made possible by funding from the United States Department of Agriculture and state and local funding.

RECOGNIZE ELDER ABUSE

Every year on June 15, World Elder Abuse Awareness Day (WEAAD) is commemorated in America and around the world. What is Elder Abuse? The Ohio Department of Aging defines Elder Abuse as follows:

- **Neglect:** failure through own action or inaction (or that of others) to meet basic needs
- **Exploitation:** improper use of another person's resources for personal benefit.
- **Physical Abuse:** intentional use of force that results in injury, pain or impairment
- **Emotional Abuse:** actions that threaten, humiliate, intimidate or otherwise psychologically hurt someone
- **Sexual Abuse:** rape or unwanted, nonconsensual sexual contact, nudity, exhibition and other sexual situations

6 THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT YOUR MEDICARE CARD

1. Your card has a Medicare Number that's unique to you, instead of your Social Security Number. This helps to protect your identity.
2. Your card is paper, which is easier for many providers to use and copy.
3. If you're in a Medicare Advantage Plan (like an HMO or PPO), your Medicare Advantage Plan ID card is your main card for Medicare—you should still keep and use it whenever you need care. And, if you have a Medicare drug plan, be sure to keep that card as well. Even if you use one of these other cards, you also may be asked to show your Medicare card, so keep it with you.
4. Only give your Medicare Number to doctors, pharmacists, other health care providers, your insurers, or people you trust to work with Medicare on your behalf.
5. Medicare uses the name and address you have on file with Social Security. To change your name and/or address, contact Val Edwards at the Senior Center for assistance or visit your online Social Security account.
6. Val Edwards, Information & Referral Specialist at the Fulton County Senior Center is available by appointment to answer your Medicare questions.

Val Edwards, Information & Referral Specialist, is prepared to help you understand Medicare and Social Security issues, insurance, bills, completing applications, and more. Val is available most weekdays by appointment to meet with seniors at the Fulton County Senior Center, 240 Clinton Street, Wauseon. Val's services are offered at no cost to seniors in partnership with Wyse Commons and the local libraries.
