## SENIOR SPOTLIGHT

“She’s my gal!” is what Orval “Jay” Beck said when he saw his buddy’s younger sister, Ruth, more than 75 years ago. Jay and his gal celebrated 72 years of marriage on June 1.

The Becks started attending the Archbold Senior Center when their friends Dale & Evelyn Quillet invited them. “It’s not easy cooking for just two of us, and it’s nice being with people. You don’t have to sit alone all the time. The food is good. You get to meet some good friends,” Ruth explained.

Jay earned a Purple Heart in 1944 serving through the United States Army during World War II. He was wounded at the Battle of Cassino. Later, he returned to Archbold and became involved in Agriculture. In 1963, Jay became part owner of Liechty Farm Equipment, Inc. He eventually became Vice-President and President until his retirement in 2011.

In 2012, Jay had the privilege of participating in an Honor Flight. In 2015, Jay was inducted into the Fulton County Agricultural Hall of Fame.

The Becks, lifetime Archbold residents, have enjoyed many winters in Florida and summers at the lake. Jay and Ruth have two children and two grandchildren.

## LATEST MEDICARE SCAMS INVOLVE DNA TESTING

Ohio's SMP (Senior Medicare Patrol) is urging seniors to beware of a new scam involving DNA testing. Fraudulent vendors contact seniors, offering to sell them a DNA testing kit for “free” genetic testing, cancer screening or DNA testing. Seniors are told the test will be completely covered by Medicare, and all that is needed to process it is their Medicare number. Later, the senior's Medicare Summary Notice will reveal high costs, as the tests are NOT covered by Medicare.

Please note that genetic testing is a Medicare-covered service in only a very limited number of cases. These include medical diagnoses relating to some types of cancers requiring chemotherapy, some forms of inherited cardiac disease, and some types of psychiatric treatment with drugs whose genetic tests may be covered by Medicare. In these instances, the testing must be ordered by a physician who is treating the patient for one of these problems.
