Marty Hardin of Wauseon is a ten-year survivor of kidney cancer. The annual Fulton County Relay for Life combines two things that are close to her heart: cancer survivors and reading. “I go to Relay for Life because I feel for the others dealing with cancer. I’ll do anything to help them. I like to read so I always go to

the Relay book sale. I bring boxes of books back here to the Senior Center and share them with the people here,” Marty explained.

As the American Cancer Society's most successful fundraiser and the organization's signature event, the mission of Relay for Life is to raise funds to improve cancer survival, decrease the incidence of cancer, and improve the quality of life for cancer patients and their caretakers.

Marty has been attending the Fulton County Senior Center since 2003. “My favorite meals are the barbequed rib sandwiches and the fish. It’s fun eating lunch every day with friends. I would tell other seniors to come out, meet people, and enjoy themselves. And you can’t get a better meal for \$2.00,” Marty said.

At the Senior Center, she enjoys playing cards and doing word puzzles and “I just like being with friends. That’s what means so much,” Marty said.

AARP SAFE DRIVERS CLASS SET FOR OCTOBER 3

Sign up now to attend the AARP Driver Safety Course at the Fulton County Senior Center, 240 Clinton Street, Wauseon, on Thursday, October 3, 7:45 am to noon. This class is open to all Fulton County seniors age 60 and over. Sign up today -- class space is limited. As a participant, you will need your current driver's license and a current AARP membership card, if you have one. AARP members pay \$15; non-AARP members pay \$20 (cash or check payable to AARP). Reserve your spot with Beth at 419-337-9299 before September 26 and reserve a noon lunch as well. This four-hour class includes watching videos and reviewing basic laws of the road. Note, no actual driving takes place during this class. According to AARP Safety Driving Instructor Leonard Stovall, this defensive driving class is a great way to recognize and eliminate bad habits. "Even if we can save just one accident, then everybody wins!" Stovall said. You will receive a certificate upon completing this class. Some insurance companies will give discounts to those who participate in the course every three years. Contact your auto insurance company to find out if you qualify for a discount. Bring \$2 (suggested donation) or a meal ticket if you are staying for lunch.

MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT

Here is what can be done during Open Enrollment, October 15th - December 7th:

- Switch from one Medicare Prescription Drug Plan to another Medicare Prescription Drug Plan
- Drop your Medicare prescription drug coverage completely
- Change from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage Plan
- Change from a Medicare Advantage Plan back to Original Medicare
- Switch from one Medicare Advantage Plan to another Medicare Advantage Plan
- Switch from a Medicare Advantage Plan that doesn't offer drug coverage to a Medicare Advantage Plan that offers drug coverage
- Switch from a Medicare Advantage Plan that does offer drug coverage to a Medicare Advantage Plan that doesn't offer drug coverage
- Join a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan

FLU IMMUNIZATIONS SCHEDULED

Two flu clinics will be offered at Fulton County Senior Centers. On Thursday, October 10 from 10:00 am to noon at the Fulton County Senior Center, 240 Clinton Street, Wauseon. Or on Monday, October 28 from 2:00 to 4:30 pm, you may attend the flu clinic at the Fayette Senior Center in the Family Life Center, 306 E. Main Street. This service is provided by the Fulton County Health Department. The Affordable Care Act has instituted a requirement for insurances to pay for immunizations and other preventive care as a "first dollar" service, meaning the member does not have to provide co-pays or meet deductibles. As a result, the Health Department will be billing contracted insurance plans for the service; many individuals will not pay "out of pocket" at the time of service. The Health Department is contracted with ten insurance plans. Medicare and Medicaid are also accepted as payment. Want to find out if your insurance plan is accepted? Call the Health Department at 419-337-0915.
