November 25, 2019

The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for conducting business of the township.

Present: Andy Brodbeck, Kenneth Leupp, Joe Short, Keith Short

Guests: Josh King, Jeff Aeschliman, Robert Apper, Karla Ball, Brian Huffman

Joe called the meeting to order at 7:30 am.

Keith presented the minutes from the November 11, 2019 meeting. Andy made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Keith presented the bills for review (attachment 09-11-19). Andy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Joe seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Burnham & Flower sent renewal rates for the Retiree Medical Plan effective January 1, 2020. There is an average rate increase of 4.8%. The age group of 65 to 69 will be \$189.34 instead of \$180.67 a month and the age group of 70 to 74 will be \$220.37 instead of \$210.28 (attachment 10-11-19). Kenneth made a motion to accept the new rates. Andy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Karla Ball, from First Insurance Group, presented a health insurance plan renewal option for a MEWA CDHP 100(3000E). This plan has a \$3,000.00 single deductible with a maximum out-of-pocket maximum is \$4,500.00. Karla will contact Keith Roth, incoming Fiscal Officer, to see if he is interested in joining our insurance plan or if he prefers to stay with his current employer's plan. Karla will inform us of Keith's decision so the trustees can decide what plan to choose.

Josh reported they plowed snow, cleaned up trucks, mowed the last of the road ditches, took a load to the landfill, cleaned up the shop, and met with the county about a sanitary issue in Elmira.

There was some discussion regarding the stop signs on Road 24.

Andy attended an EMA meeting last week and feels that board is working well. Andy will be serving on the executive board.

Kenneth made a motion to adjourn at 9:06 am. Andy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
