January 6, 2020

The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in special session to discuss placing a tile along Road 25.

Present: Andy Brodbeck, Kenneth Leupp, Joe Short, Keith Short

Guests: Josh King, Jeff Aeschliman, Roger Stuckey, Douglas Stuckey, David Pugh, Rod Creager, Nate Wilhelm, Lincoln Nafziger, Neal Beck, Dave Damman

Joe called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

Rod Creager presented documentation for the tile in Branch 6 of Flat Run Creek that was in place in 1908 including the current landowners and the percentage of acreage owned that will drain into the tile (attachment 01-01-20).

Roger Stuckey said he explained to the adjoining landowners the project and the percentage each would owe for the project. The tile would be placed along the west side of the road from the catch basin south to the ditch in the property owned by Lincoln Nafziger.

Doug Stuckey asked if a catch basin could be installed that would help drain his property when there is a large rain.

Neal Beck is not opposed to the project but he does not think the project will benefit him. His driveway will need to be replaced and his yard will need to be reseeded. He does not feel any financial responsibility for the project.

Roger Stuckey thinks Neal will receive some drainage benefit.

Lincoln Nafziger said there is a ditch that is closer and wondered if that could be used. Dave Damman said the natural flow of water is going south and this would probable raise the cost.

The current tile serves the township as it is currently in place.

Dave Damman said his part of the project is \$7,200.00 but that does not include any cement work to repair Neal Beck's driveway or a catch basin. Brett Ripke will perform the repair of Mr. Beck's driveway.

Neal Beck said if his concrete is replaced as it is now, he is willing to pay his 2.7% share of the project.

The percentages of the project are Lincoln Nafziger 32.0%, Neal Beck 2.7%, Roger Stuckey 13.3%, Valetta Stuckey 49.3%, and German Township 2.7%. All parties agreed to pay according to these percentages. Roger Stuckey will pay for the project and the remaining parties will reimburse Roger for the share.

A standard catch basin will be placed in the V of the ditch which will be an added cost for the project.

Andy made a motion to adjourn at 12:40 pm. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
