April 27, 2020

The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for conducting business of the township.

Andy called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Keith presented the minutes from April 13, 2020 meeting. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Joe seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Keith presented the bills for review (attachment 06-04-20). Joe made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh and Jeff have been doing some leveling and seeding from some ditch repairs. They have been grading road birms, as well as some work with the dirt patcher. Josh says the JD Tractor is ready with mower mounted at Kenn-Feld. Did work for Doug Rupp on 24-3, dipped a section of ditch out and Doug wants some work done. Doug would like to see about another half mile done total between road G and 24-3 to drain the water spot. The ground has been in the CRP program the last 15 years and Doug is getting ready to start farming it. Josh is going to get in touch with engineer Rod Krieger to look at the options.

Josh obtained some prices on possible road projects (attachment 07-04-20). Discussion on the possibility of moving forward with asphalt repair at B and 24 intersection going approximately 400 feet to the west with a cost of \$15,120. Also some discussion on moving forward with crack sealing on B from village limits to 21 as well as on 24 from railroad to 20-A. Those two projects would cost approximately \$37,600 with the village sharing on small portion of the cost on 24 from the railroad to road D.

Discussion on Co Rd B and 24 resurfacing project and the amount of funds available with the OPWC grant. Looking at the possibility of widening road 24 from the Bridge to railroad tracks and Joe will check to see if that can be included in the grant from OPWC.

Joe mentioned the need to do something with old township building. No discussion at this time.

Joe made a motion to adjourn at 8:22 am. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
