The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for conducting business of the township.

Present: Andy Brodbeck, Kenneth Leupp, Joe Short, Keith Roth

Guests: Josh King, Bob Apper, Brad Grime, David Pugh

Andy called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Keith presented the minutes from May 11, 2020 meeting. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Joe seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Keith presented the bills for review (attachment 02-05-20). Kenneth made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Joe seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh reported on maintenance. They have been doing some fire truck service work. Had some high water last week with several roads closed and had three high water signs stolen which are going to have to be replaced. They have both new mowers ready and will start mowing ditches this week. Ron Burkholder called with issue, neighbor is tiling field and will connect to road tile and concerned about more water going into that tile. Joe mentioned he thought German Twp did not allow people to connect into road tiles in the past. Rod Creager will be contacted about the situation. Randy Stuckey had a flooding issue along road F between 24 and 25, he believes there is an old tile going under the road and he wants a catch basin put in. He wants to know if the catch basin can go in the right away but there was some discussion that then German Twp would be responsible for maintaining it. More information needed to make decision on that issue. Brian Horst had tile issue on Rd C, and Josh referred him to the county.

Discussed Co Rd B project; Blausey came back and fixed the issues the first time. Now there appears to be some grading issues and need to make sure all the engineer guidelines were followed before issuing final payment.

Rd BC and 25 there is some tile/water issues. There is some very old tile there, which is a private tile but not exactly sure which way the water flows, either to the east or to the west or both. Williams County cleaned tile at one time but did not really fix the problem. There was a quote at one time for Williams County to fix the issue but the work was never done.

There is a catch basin at Mike Kennedy's house that sits too high and needs addressed. Josh believes that issue can be fixed.
