SENIOR SPOTLIGHT



When Dick Clark said, “Music is the soundtrack of your life,” he could have used Charlie and Barb Lane of rural Swanton as an excellent example. Charlie learned to play piano at age 8. He has continued to use his musical gifts at church throughout the years. Barb was around 10 years old when she learned to play the upright player piano that her grandma gave to her mom. Total, the couple has roughly 140 years of piano playing between them!

Their musical paths crossed years before they actually met each other. “Charlie and I were in a piano recital together as kids at the Sports Arena. I still have the panoramic photo my mom took of the group on the day we both played. We were young kids at the same recital, but didn’t know each other until we met years later!” Barb explained.

Following high school Graduation, Charlie served in the Army for three years, then drove a semi-truck regionally. In retirement, Charlie started playing violin and upright bass. Barb worked as a bookkeeper. Now, Barb also plays the violin, and she recently started playing the banjo. “I used to have dairy goats. I would take my banjo out to the field and play for the goats,” Barb said with a laugh.

MUSICAL TRIP SCHEDULED

The Fulton Co. Senior Center is now taking reservations for a day trip to the historic Tibbits Opera House, Coldwater, Michigan for a live musical matinee performance, "Godspell" on Wednesday, July 6, 2022.

WHAT IS IT?

Choir – More voices are always welcome to join this group who enjoys singing. You'll find a light-hearted comradery here. The Choir occasionally performs at other Senior Center sites, nursing homes, etc.

Golden Drummers – This no-cost exercise class raises your heart rate while you tap out rhythms to music. Choose your own intensity level as you tap drumsticks on large, stationary, exercise balls. Stand or sit for this class. No experience needed; simply follow the instructor.

Line Dancing – A great way to combine fitness and fun for both the body and brain. Features various music styles, not just country! New dancers are welcome anytime.

Pepper – A trick-taking card game with an element of bidding. Four players to a table, your partner is across the table from you.

Pickleball - an active game that is a cross between table tennis and tennis. It looks a lot like tennis, but it features smaller courts, a wiffle-type ball, and a smooth paddle. Both beginner and experienced players are welcome.

Silver Sneakers Classic – A fitness instructor from Fulton County Health Center leads this exercise class. Choose your intensity level and improve your muscle tone, flexibility and endurance. Stand for this class or sit as needed. Use small, handheld weights, plus exercise bands and small exercise balls.

Sketching – gather with seniors who share a love of sketching. All experience levels are welcome.

Tai Chi – This senior-led exercise class increases balance & flexibility & fights stress. Follow an on-screen instructor via DVD. Movements are slow and fluid.

PICKLEBALL

Due to the success of the Fulton County Senior Center Pickleball program, we are pleased to offer more playing time on the court, as well as the opportunity for seniors with similar skill levels to play together.

Currently, the gym at the Fulton County Senior Center in Wauseon (240 Clinton Street) is open more hours each weekday for Pickleball games. Refer to the activity calendar in this newsletter for Pickleball times. Please note the Gold, Silver and Bronze categories will allow seniors with similar goals and skill levels to play together. Use the chart below to determine whether you are a Gold, Silver or Bronze player.

A Bronze Player

- plays primarily for social reasons and/ or to get physical exercise
- and/ or has limited experience
- understands fundamentals
- understands court positioning
- has some basic stroke and footwork skills

A Silver Player

- demonstrates a broad knowledge of the rules of the game
- puts more strategy into the game
- has good footwork
- is able to communicate and move well with a partner
- is able to identify and attack their opponents' weaknesses

A Gold Player

- is looking for a more aggressive game
- has mastered the strategies
- has efficient footwork
- can easily adjust their game to opponents' strengths & weaknesses
- rarely makes unforced errors

COUPONS FOR LOCAL FARMERS' MARKETS

If you are age 60 or over and a resident of Fulton County, you may be eligible to receive coupons from the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program. Eligible seniors receive ten \$5 coupons and a list of participating farmers' markets and roadside stands. Coupons can be redeemed for fresh vegetables and fruits plus herbs and honey. Income is based upon the income of the total number of people living in the household.

You will automatically receive an application in the mail for 2022 if you received coupons for local farmers' markets in 2021. Coupons will be sent monthly. If you are homebound, you may assign a proxy to shop for produce for you. If you are new to the program and would like to apply for farmers' market coupons for the 2022 season, pick up an application at any of our five Senior Center sites. Each household must complete an application every year. Submit your completed application to Laura Ankney at the Wauseon site or to Area Office on Aging, Toledo. The application is also online at www.areaofficeonaging.com and click on the "Apply Now" button.

All applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. The Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program is made possible by funding from the United States Department of Agriculture and state and local funding.
