The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Kenneth at 7:00 pm.

Bill Rufenacht introduced himself as a candidate for Fulton County Commissioner.

The minutes from the January 23, 2012 meeting were presented. Randy made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The January 2012 bank reconciliation was presented for review.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 02-02-12). Bruce made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Josh reported they have been plowing and salting roads, cold patching, some berming and have been cutting trees.

The January financial reports were presented for review.

We have received the Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Revenues from the Fulton County Auditor's office (attachment 03-02-12).

Randy attended the Township Association meeting in Columbus. He stated they stressed that we should be proactive in contacting our elected officials about keeping the township form of government in place. He attended many good sessions.

Bruce was contacted by Brad Short from Liechty Farm Equipment regarding the loader that was quoted on the tractor that was ordered earlier this year. In order to get the loader that was requested there will be an additional charge of not more than \$100.00. Bruce made a motion to accept the change to the quote at a cost not exceeding \$100.00. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Robert Apper has been helping in the trimming of trees in the Goll Woods area using his own chain saw and fuel. Randy made a motion to pay Robert Apper a fee of \$400.00 for his time and material. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
