The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Randy at 7:00 pm.

The minutes from the March 11, 2013 meeting were presented. Randy made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with two yes votes and no negative votes.

Randy spoke with Randy Merillat regarding the proposed road switch with the County plowing Co Rd 20 from State Route 2 South to the Henry County line and in exchange the Township plowing Co Rd D from Co Rd 22 to the Williams County line. Bruce made a motion to try this switch for next year. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with two yes votes and no negative votes.

There was some discussion regarding the suggested road repair list for this year. A few of the roads will be reviewed will discuss it again at the next meeting.
