Board of Trustees
July 22, 2013

The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

Present: Bruce Lauber, Kenneth Leupp, Randy Ruffer, Keith Short

Guests: Dan Leininger, Scott Haselman

The meeting was called to order by Randy Ruffer at 7:00 pm.

Scott Haselman discussed the survey for the 305 W. Mechanic Street property. The alleys could be vacated or left as is. If the alleys are vacated then the property is split between the land owners.

Kenneth made a motion to accept the surveyed property as is. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Bruce made a motion appointing Randy Ruffer the authority to finalize any and all transactions necessary to close purchase of the property and to apply for a new deed. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The minutes from the July 8, 2013 meeting were presented. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 03-07-13). Bruce made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Dan reported they have been patching roads and serviced the back hoe. Tony Wyse, on Co Rd 27, is having some problems with water washing away his driveway. The trustees will check out the property. Dan asked if they could run a camera through the blocked tile in Elmira. The trustees granted the request.

Randy spoke with Sam Smucker and Sam asked if the Village of Archbold could try to clear the tile. The homeowners would like to know if the tile is plugged and if so where it is plugged.

Bruce suggested we should put up cement blocks in the existing building to make it more secure.

Kenneth said Oglesby Construction was awarded the road striping for the county and he will check if they are interested in striping the township roads.

Randy asked what the Zoning policy states regarding house trailers in the township.

Kenneth moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:46 pm and Bruce seconded it. Motion carried with three yes votes and no negative votes.
