The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

Dan recommended purchasing 175 ton. Bruce made a motion to purchase 175 ton. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
