The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Bruce at 7:00 pm.

Randy Oyer reported that they are having a problem with drainage in Elmira. He has contacted some contractors to provide estimates to repair the problem. Randy will continue to make the township aware of their plans.

Albert Garcia shared that they would appreciate consideration for any crack sealing work we might have.

The March zoning report was submitted for review (attachment 01-04-14).

The minutes from the March 24, 2014 meeting were presented. Randy made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with two yes votes and no negative votes.

The bank reconciliation for March was presented for review.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 02-04-14). Randy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The financial reports for March were presented for review.

Kenneth said the Regional Planning reviewed the Zoning Variance from Dale Burkholder.

Randy contacted Scott Haselman and also Heidi with the Ohio Township Association with some legal questions regarding Co Rd 24. Randy has received some bids for a new truck. The Freightliner truck bid is \$141,101.00 and the Western Star is \$146,182.00.

Bruce recommended that we have ideas what roads need to be worked on at our next meeting.

Bruce had someone contact him with some interest in the building on State Route 66.

Andy Brodbeck stated that his officers would be in favor of using the building on State Route 66 as a place for training of firemen. They would like to use it for a long term relationship.

Josh said Snow's Fire Protection inspected the fire extinguishers and recommended there should be a couple more extinguishers in the facility. They have been servicing trucks and have some exhaust work to complete on a couple of fire trucks. They flushed out the tile by Mike Stuckey's property.
