The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

Present: Bruce Lauber, Kenneth Leupp, Randy Ruffer

The meeting was called to order by Bruce at 7:00 pm.

Linda Lauber gave her report about zoning issues in the township (attachment 01-07-14). The Warren Sauder property on Co. Rd. B was in violation of zoning regulations.

Robert Apper reported on cemetery activity. He presented copies of the Rules and Regulations of German Township Cemeteries; Adopted January 2007. After reviewing them, it was decided Keith Short should write Wanda Bowditch and address her request to transfer her plots to her sons. The plots must be sold back to the township at the purchase price of \$30.00.

We discussed various terms for renting the old Township Garage. Randy recorded all the terms and will give them to Keith so he can put them into a written document. Olley Short and Jeff Litogot came in and we discussed the terms with them and gave them a key to the building. They plan to move in and be open Aug. 1, 2014. The initial lease agreement will be for one (1) year.

The financial reports for June were presented for review.

Josh King reported that he and Dan Leininger had been trimming trees at Johnson's Cemetery, cleaning out the old building, and cleaning out nests and bird proofing the new building..

Bruce reported on the meeting he attended regarding the county fire department proposals.
