The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the Township.

Present: Bruce Lauber, Kenneth Leupp and Randy Ruffer

Absent: Keith Short

Guests: Dan Leininger, Mika Frankenfield and Dean Frankenfield

The meeting was called to order by Bruce Lauber at 7:00 pm.

The minutes from the Sept 8, 2014 meeting were presented. Randy moved to accept the minutes as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 09-09-14). Randy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Mika and Dean Frankenfield came to the meeting to request permission to connect several downspouts from Mika's house to the township's road tile at a catch basin in their front yard. The trustees approved their request contingent on Dan Leininger's inspection of the size of the tile. (Dan later reported the tile had the capacity to handle the additional water.)

Bruce Lauber presented a request for Blanket Certificates on Keith Short's behalf in the following areas.

Randy moved to accept the request. Kenneth seconded it. The motion passed with three yes votes and no opposing votes.

The trustees discussed the Public Notice from the Four County Solid Waste District regarding the public comment period for the new district plan.

Dan Leininger reported they have patched roads, flushed tile, worked at the old shop building, cutting rerod, put berm around the foundation, worked on the salt shed doors, and trimmed trees in Pettisville.

Dan said they had contacted Freightliner and the new dump truck is done. It will be shipped to Lima soon.

Dan said they contacted Morton Salt and our letter will be coming near the end of the month. He asked that we get 250 tons of salt this year.

We all discussed a drainage issue in an alley between Cline Bros. Roofing and the Vogel Family in Burlington. We took no action.

Randy talked about putting a pole light near the salt building. We took no action.
