November 24, 2014

The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Bruce at 7:00 pm.

The minutes from the November 10, 2014 meeting were presented. Kenneth made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 5-11-14). Randy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Dan reported they put up a curtain in the shop, salted and plowed snow, serviced the pickup.

An estimate from Mike Short was received quoting 8" tile to repair tile on County Road F between County Road 20 and County Road 19 by property owned by Brian Aeschliman (attachment 06-11-14). The trustees had agreed to pay for a 6" tile. Randy made a motion to accept the quote. Kenneth seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Andy said the new turnout gear has been shipped. The department has received their new boots. Andy said some the firefighters would like to take their hold helmets home. The trustees said they could take them home if they want them. They had a fire with the Wauseon Department at CDD, Inc. and some of the turnout gear, boots and hose were damaged. Andy submitted an invoice for \$11,100.00 for the damaged equipment. Andy will be attending a meeting with the Fulton County Commissioners on November 25 concerning a new contract. The department had a very good Feather Party. It is possible an engine will need to be rebuilt in 2015.

Kenneth attended the EMA meeting and it was decided that we will be billed the same in 2015 as 2014.

Randy said he contacted Randy Oyer about wiring a light pole at the salt building.

Kenneth made a motion to adjourn at 8:49 pm. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
