The Trustees of German Township, Fulton County, Ohio met in regular session for the purpose of conducting business of the township.

The meeting was called to order by Kenneth at 7:00 pm.

Olley and Jeff, from Xtreme Automotive Detailing, reported they have been experiencing some power outages at our old building, the hot water heater is not working, the toilet needs some attention, the garage doors do not seal and the furnace isn't working and wondered whose responsibility this was. Bruce suggested we will check into these problems.

The minutes from the March 9, 2015 meeting were presented. Bruce made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Randy seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

The bills were presented for review (attachment 05-03-15). Randy made a motion to accept the bills for payment as presented. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Dan reported they have done some work on his truck, the catch basin on Co Rd 26 should be replaced and they still don't have an estimate for the light pole in Pettisville that was damaged.

Randy received a notice from the Fulton County Engineer's office regarding the bridge replacement on Co Rd 26 showing our estimated portion to be \$7,410.00 (attachment 06-03-15). The project has a bid opening date of March 24, 2015 at 10:00 am. Randy made a motion to accept the estimate. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Kenneth spoke with Frank Onweller, Fulton County Engineer, about applying to buy salt through ODOT. After much discussion, Randy made a motion to not participate in the summer fill bid for salt through ODOT. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.

Andy reported about the EMS contract and that there will be more meetings in the future.

Randy made a motion to adjourn at 9:14 pm. Bruce seconded the motion. The motion passed with three yes votes and no negative votes.
