Fulton County Courthouse Receives Heritage Award

Fulton County Courthouse was presented by Heritage Ohio the Best Public Building Rehabilitation Award to the Fulton County Commissioners as part of Ohio's Preservation Month (October).

"When so many counties are struggling with their historic courthouses, it is indeed admirable to see the depth and commitment by the commissioners and citizens of Fulton County," said Joyce Barrett, Executive Director of Heritage Ohio, statewide revitaliation nonprofit.

The Italianate Tuscan Villa style courthouse was built in 1872 for a cost of \$45,722.27. The 2019, 10-month, rehabilitation project had a budget of \$3.86 million combining funds from the county's Title Bureau and \$2.5 million collected from court user fees.

FCEDC on Arche Engery Project, LLC

Arche Energy Project, LLC has proposed a significant solar energy development near the Village of Fayette. The proposal will generate 107 MW of electric energy that would be placed for electric power users to purchase. The company is securing land under option agreements

and is currently completing the regulatory requirements necessary for development. The project will generate revenue for the Gorham-Fayette School District, Gorham Township, Fulton County and other local government jurisdictions that depend on property taxes for revenues. The Fulton County Economic Development Corporation (FCEDC) has been working with representatives from the Arche Energy Project, LLC to help them understand local requirements necessary for successful development. Matt Gilroy, Executive Director of the FCEDC shared, “this proposed solar energy project is a significant boon to the northwest part of Fulton County. This business will provide many employment opportunities during their construction process, which will take more than a year, and will provide significant tax revenues to local governments. If the project comes to fruition, Fayette’s school district will receive nearly a half-million in new revenues annually for the next thirty or more years. I was also very impressed when the company reached out to me early in the pandemic and asked to make a donation to a food bank in the Fayette area that services local residents; the company wants to be involved and engaged in the community and the county.”

Follow these guidelines for a fun and safe experience:

- Perform health screen prior to leaving home - do not participate if feeling sick
- If living with people who may be at greater risk from COVID-19, please reconsider participating
- If child is at greater risk of complications from COVID-19, contact your doctor before participating
- Masks should be worn at all times
- Stay with your family unit & in your own neighborhood if possible
- Stay six feet away from other families
- Limit one family at a time when approaching houses
- Use hand sanitizer frequently during collection
- Collection bag should have a wide mouth to allow for dropping treats inside
- Do not eat any candy while participating
- If possible, wipe of candy wrappers with sanitizing wipes (allow to dry) when arriving home & prior to eating candy
- Wash hands before eating candy
