More specifically, for the purpose of ensuring due process, respect, fairness, and justice for crime victims and their families in the criminal and juvenile justice systems, the amendment would provide victims with:</p> <ul data-bbox="396 852 1422 1230" style="list-style-type: none">• the right to privacy and to be treated with respect, fairness, and dignity;• the right to information about the rights and services available to crime victims;• the right to notification in a timely manner of all proceedings in the case;• the right to be present and heard at all court proceedings, including the right to petition the court to protect the victim's rights;• the right to a prompt conclusion of the case;• to refuse discovery requests made by the accused, except as authorized by Article I, Section 10 of the Ohio constitution;• the right to reasonable protection from the accused;• the right to notice of the release or escape of the accused; and• the right to restitution. <p data-bbox="347 1268 1442 1331">The proposed amendment would not establish a cause of action for damages or compensation against the state or any political subdivision.</p> <p data-bbox="347 1369 1182 1398">If approved, the amendment will be effective 90 days after the election.</p> <p data-bbox="347 1436 919 1465">Shall the amendment be approved?
