The March 17, 2020 Primary Election has been suspended (postponed) until June 2, 2020.

By order of the Director of the Ohio Department of Health and Ohio Secretary of State Frank LaRose's Directive 2020-06.

All Fulton County Voting Locations – 17 in total are Closed and voting will not take place today March 17, 2020

SOS Directive 2020-06 offers an extended absentee voting period by mail only:

Ballot Applications must be postmarked by May 26, 2020 in order to have the ballot mailed.

Voted Absentee ballots must be postmarked by June 1, 2020 and received by the board of Elections no later than June 12, 2020 to be considered timely.

UOCAVA absentee ballots must be submitted for mailing not later than 12:01 am at the place where the voter completes the ballot, on Tuesday, June 2, 2020

Voters with an unforeseeable hospitalization may submit applications beginning after Tuesday, May 26, 2020 and ending at 3:00pm on Tuesday, June 2, 2020. The Board of Elections Office can provide detailed options in this category.

June 2, 2020 – Presidential Primary Election in Ohio

Polls will be open 6:30am – 7:30pm for In Person Election Day Voting
