

Purple Martin House



Materials:

- 4' x 8' x 1/4" plywood.
- 2" x 2" x 6" for chimney.
- 1" x 2" x 14' for base.
- 1" x 1" x 8' for corner blocks.
- 4" x 8" metal window screen.
- 4" x 4" x 14' cedar post.

Place 1/2" dowel railing around balcony to keep young from falling.




This pattern shows how to cut out a martin house from one sheet of plywood.



Layout pattern.

Expanded view of Martin House. A threaded rod inserts through the base and up through the chimney.

Entrance hole diameter: 2 1/4".

Locate 5/8" ventilation holes 1" below top edge of sides.

** For sides, measurement from floor to center of entrance holes = 2 1/8".*

Note: This plan is for a one-story house. To add a second story, make one more ceiling unit (25" x 25"), four more sides, and four more room partitions.
